# Worry hotline: 1 Peter 5:7

Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. NIV

Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you. KJV

## Fear hotline: Isaiah 41:10

So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. NIV

Fear thou not; for I *am* with thee: be not dismayed; for I *am* thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. KJV

## *Temptation hotline: 1 Corinthians 10:13*

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it. NIV

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear *it*. KJV

## Doubt hotline: Romans 10:17

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ. NIV

So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. KJV

## Sickness hotline: Psalms 34:18

The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit. NIV

The LORD *is* nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. KJV

## Loneliness hotline: Deuteronomy 31:8

The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. NIV

And the LORD, he *it is* that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed. KJV
